On Monday, May 6, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. at the City Hall, 314 North Main Street, the Common Council of the City of Alma will hold a public hearing for the public regarding the following proposed ordinance: An ordinance amending Chapter 73: Traffic Schedules Section II, One-Way Streets. Pine Street from Hwy 35 to River Street will be one-way Westerly and Orange Street between River Street and Hwy 35 will become one-way Easterly. River Street between Pine and Orange Streets will be two-way traffic).

High School Road will be one-way with entrance from the South and exiting onto Spring Creek Road to the north.

On Monday, May 6, 2019 at 5:45 p.m. at the City Hall, 314 North Main Street, the Common Council of the City of Alma will hold a public hearing for the public regarding the following proposed ordinance: An ordinance amending Chapter 72: Parking. Amendment to Section 72.22 (B)(1) and 72.22 (B)(2) -- No Parking shall be on River Street between Pine and Orange Street on the East side. This ordinance shall also amend Chapter 72.22 (A)(2) One-hour parking shall be repealed as the single parking space designated therein, in front of 200 S. Main Street, is hereby ordained to be restored to a regular Twenty-Four Hour Parking space and the description of which shall be added to Chapter 72.20 (A). In addition, the current parking space in front of 120 South Main Street shall be restored to a Twenty-Four-hour parking space and shall be removed from the "No-Parking" classification thereby amending section 72.22 (B)(2).
