

ORDINANCE #24-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 52: SEWERS §52.28 (E) APPLICATION FOR SEWER SERVICE OF THE CITY OF ALMA'S CODE OF ORDINANCES.

(4) (i) Property owners who are not connected to the City's water system but wish to have their private wells metered to determine water entering into the City's sewage system for sewage billing purposes shall file an application in writing to the City on a form furnished at the Office of the City Clerk. Applications shall only be accepted by the City during the final three months of each budget year (October, November, December).

(ii) Users shall purchase the meters at their own expense from the City and shall be solely responsible for the installation and maintenance of the meter and the water system.

(iii) After installation by a licensed plumber, users shall make their premises available for inspection as prescribed by Wis. Stats. 196.171.

(iv) If the inspection shows intentional attempt to avoid or bypass the water meter to reduce the correct reading of the meter, the user shall be subject to penalty as described in 52.28 (c)(2).

Duly adopted by the Common Council of the City of Alma on July 11, 2024 with a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.

This ordinance shall be effective on it's publication date.
